

Focus on both equipment status and correct handling

One area we discuss during a Performance Audit is the correct setting and usage of the Alfa Laval equipment, which can be at least as important as the equipment itself. For example, running the separators at too low temperature increases the risk of cat fines reaching, and potentially destroying, the engine. A simple change of handling procedure will improve the effectiveness of the equipment as well as the safety of your engine operation.

Typically, we focus on the following equipment:

- High-speed separators
- Gasketed plate heat exchangers
- Freshwater generators



Securing operation

When separators running with the wrong flows and temperatures contributed to crankshaft damage on board the Alexander von Humboldt in 2009, Jan De Nul Group made a strategic decision. All 72 ships in their fleet would have a Performance Audit every 2.5 years, along with annual crew training, as part of their regular maintenance programs.

"Despite all available manuals, the human factor creates mistakes," says Marc Ruyssinck, Fleet Manager for Jan De Nul. 
